CALL TO ORDER

ITEM: Chairperson DeMoss called the meeting to order at 6:34 PM.

ROLL CALL; DECLARATION OF QUORUM; PUBLIC NOTICE

ITEM: Chairperson DeMoss, Alderwoman Kroupa, Commissioners Ament, Hemmen, Marquardt, Orzel, Tyskiewicz and Warczak.

It should be noted that there is a vacancy on the Commission due to the resignation of Commissioner Hermann. Mayor Ament is currently interviewing candidates.

1. Commissioner/Treasurer Warczak noted that the \$56.53 reimbursement to Chairperson DeMoss for last month's expenditures for the two Recognition Events, has not been issued as of the November 1, 2022 City Treasurer's Report Form.
 2. Thus, our Commission's present balance remains at \$782.00.
 3. The City Budget was passed for 2023, and shows that our Commission will again have \$2000.00 in our budget.

Chair DeMoss: final review of revised document with inclusion of City of New Berlin Cutler/Kern/Kimball and Imig/Woelfel Landmarks along with Arcadian Hills Residential Historic District informational; to occur when completed document received from DCD
STATUS PENDING the review by DCD. Besides checking with Ed Bartz, Head of Parks and Grounds, for the QR Codes for the newest landmarks, Commissioner Ament will also relay to him that the A.E. Gilbert Mansion on Calhoun Road has lost its’ QR Code sign, possibly during the road construction on Calhoun Road.

b. Discussion ensued that next May might be a good time for the “Fifth Trivia Challenge,” with possible tie-in to the State’s Historic Preservation Month or a focus on our newest landmarks.
