5. TABLED ITEMS

A. **22-20:** Alderman Stribl (via a resident) has requested changing the intersection of Michele Witmer Memorial Drive and Library Lane from a two-way stop sign to a four-way stop sign. **(Tabled for a traffic study)**

Pichler advised he completed numerous traffic counts at the intersection of Michele Witmer Memorial Drive and Library Lane, which yielded unusual data, but he was able to determine the peak hour of traffic was between 7:30 AM – 8:30 AM. Pichler advised he conducted an additional traffic count on 05/25/23, between 7:30 AM – 8:30 AM, to obtain the data needed to determine if a multi-way/4-way stop sign was warranted. Based on the guidance from Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 2009 Edition, Section 2B.07 Multiway Stop Applications, the data collected yielded the following results:

Warrant A – not applicable
Warrant B – not met
Warrant C1 – not met
Warrant C2 – not met
Warrant C3 – not applicable
Warrant D – not met

Pichler advised based on the data collected, a four-way stop at the intersection of Michele Witmer Memorial Drive and Library Lane was not warranted. Pichler did advise there were some possible vision obstructions that could be addressed by having some of the trees near the intersection trimmed. Pichler also advised having “Cross Traffic Does Not Stop” signs installed could provide additional warnings. Pichler suggested taking a multiple step approach to addressing the concern by first having the trees trimmed and then, if there were still concerns, considering the installation of “Cross Traffic Does Not Stop” signs.

MOTION: Motion to have the Streets Department trim the trees on the northwest corner of Michele Witmer Memorial Drive and Library Lane and in the surrounding medians.
