4. SAFETY SATURDAY

A. Discussion pertaining to the 2024 Event Planning

The Safety Saturday Committee assists in the planning and organization of Safety Saturday. The mission of Safety Saturday is to provide a free and safe event for the community. Safety Saturday is scheduled for May 18, 2024 from 9 AM to 1 PM at the Children's Hospital site.

The Commission discussed activities and vendors that have confirmed for 2024 such as; the bouncy houses, rock climbing wall, DJ, Natty Oaks, Sprecher booth, chairs, generators, 520 bike helmet handouts, Murphy & Prachthausen life vest handouts, Miss New Berlin and demonstrations.

Volunteers will be needed to; chaperon the bouncy houses, set-up, take-down, traffic control, and collect garbage. Employees from Froedtert will assist with hand-out and fit the bike helmets. The DNR will assist with hand-out and fit the life vests. Commissioner Buer will contact the Girl Scouts as possible volunteers.

Officer Fus met with representatives from the New Berlin Public Library regarding "Touch A Truck" event that was previously handled by the Recreation Department. The program will be at Safety Saturday this year including trucks from the city Streets, Utilities, and Buildings & Grounds Departments. Discussion continued regarding the possibility of having the first hour be sensory free as in the past. The possibility of

having an ice-cream truck was also discussed.
