Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 7.53(2), the Municipal Board of Canvassers (MBOC) for the City of New Berlin is composed of the municipal clerk and two other qualified electors of the municipality, appointed by the municipal clerk. The MBOC is required to convene following each election in which local contests appear on the ballot. In such instances, the Board is responsible for conducting the canvass of municipal election returns, completing the official canvass statement, certifying the election results, and formally determining the successful candidates. All candidates are notified of the certified results via email following the completion of the canvass. If there are no municipal offices or referenda on the ballot, the MBOC may still meet after the election to review any outstanding provisional ballots related to state, federal, or other non-local contests, or to address any other relevant matters associated with the canvass.

Please note that the New Berlin School District, Elmbrook School District, Muskego-Norway School District, West Allis-West Milwaukee School District, and Waukesha County each maintain their own Boards of Canvassers for the certification of their respective election results.
