Discussion pertaining to the 2026 event exhibitors

Officer Komorowski reported that positive feedback from exhibitors and the majority of the exhibitors will be returning for 2026 such as; the inflatable attractions, DJ, Nice Bites ice cream, chairs, generators, and demonstrations. Natty Oaks will operate their food truck for the event. The necessary permits will be obtained from City Hall. A final email will be going out to the exhibitors reminding them of the deadline to register is April 15, 2026. Students from New Berlin West will be volunteering to chaperone the inflatable attractions other volunteers may be needed for set-up, take-down, traffic control, collect garbage, and assist with *hand-outs*. *The search for a face-painting vendor still continues. The Brewers have been contacted requesting trading cards for hand-outs. Ordering the Port-A-Johns is a work in progress. Target and Fleet Farm have been contacted requesting a donation of water. If there is no response, the water will be purchased. The helmets have been received and will be advertised that they are for ages 2–16. The NB Library will be helping with advertising.*
