Officer Komorowski reported that positive feedback from exhibitors and the majority of the exhibitors will be returning for 2026 such as; the inflatable attractions, DJ, Nice Bites ice cream, chairs, generators, and demonstrations. Natty Oaks will operate their food truck for the event. The necessary permits have been obtained from city hall. Students from New Berlin West and New Berlin Eisenhower will be volunteering to chaperone the inflatable attractions.
